

Finger-travelling

Czech Republic, 23. 8. – 4. 9. 2021

About the project:

Interculturalism is one of the hottest topics in Europe these days. It is becoming more and more important to discover other countries and cultures and learn to work in an intercultural team. The main aim of the project is to help young people to understand the cultural realities of other countries and find friends from abroad from which they can learn a lot.



After the teambuilding activities are done, we will start “finger-travelling” around Europe and we will “visit” 4 countries (since 4 countries are involved in the project). There will be one day dedicated to each country – the national team from this country will lead the programme and teach the others about their culture, history, traditions, etc. We will finish each day by cooking a typical dish for dinner.

By leading quite big parts of the programme themselves (when introducing their countries), the participants will also gain valuable experience of organizing activities for other people and they will develop their leadership skills.

Besides that, we will organize debates and games in order to dive deeper into the



intercultural dialogue. We will have plenty of time to enjoy our beautiful campsite – we can go canoeing, swim in the river, play games in the forest, etc. We will also organize a trip to Prague, Český Krumlov or other town (we will make a democratic selection). We will also for sure have time to visit the nearby town Tábor.

Accommodation:

We will be staying in an attractive touristic location on a bank of the river Lužnice. In the morning you can enjoy the beautiful view of the river covered in steam and at night you can watch the sky full of stars. We will be quite far from civilization, which is a wonderful opportunity to have a rest from all the civilization. We will also provide you with good food according to your taste and wishes.

Staying in the countryside also means that you will not be living in a five-star hotel. We will be accommodated in four cottages and share three bathrooms. You need to bring a warm sleeping bag, towel, shoes you will be able to use in wet grass, slippers to wear in the cottages and a torch.

We like our camp and its surroundings very much and so we will teach you how to keep it clean and nice. We will show you how to sort the waste and how to put dirty dishes into the washing machine, so that we leave the place as beautiful as we found it.

You need to arrive on the **23rd August** and leave on the **4th September**.

Here is how much money we can give you for your tickets:

| Country | Number of participants | Travel grant per one person |

When booking the tickets, please consider that the transport in the Czech Republic will also cost some money. Please, try to find the cheapest tickets possible.

DON'T BUY ANY TICKETS WITHOUT CONFIRMATION FROM OUR SIDE! OTHERWISE WE WILL NOT PAY YOU THE REIMBURSEMENT.

Also, it is obligatory for all participants to get **TRAVEL INSURANCE**.

When travelling in the Czech Republic by train, keep in mind that:

- it is much cheaper to buy the ticket for the whole group together than separately
- students only pay 25% of the full price, but you need to **have your ISIC card with you**.
