Green travel:

- ▶ For those countries that are closer to the Czech Republic, we are offering the option of „green travel“. Your travel budget (see the table on previous page) can be higher if you use a „green means of travel“.
- ▶ „Green means of travel“ is pretty much everything but flying and driving a car alone. It covers: train, bus, carsharing, bike and any other low-emission means of transport.
- ▶ In order to receive the „green travel“ budget, you have to use green means of transport for the main part of your journey – so if you take your car to drive 10 km to the train station, it is not a problem.

- ▶ Please, don't buy any tickets within Czech Republic. Once we will know about your departures and arrivals, we will organize the transport altogether.
